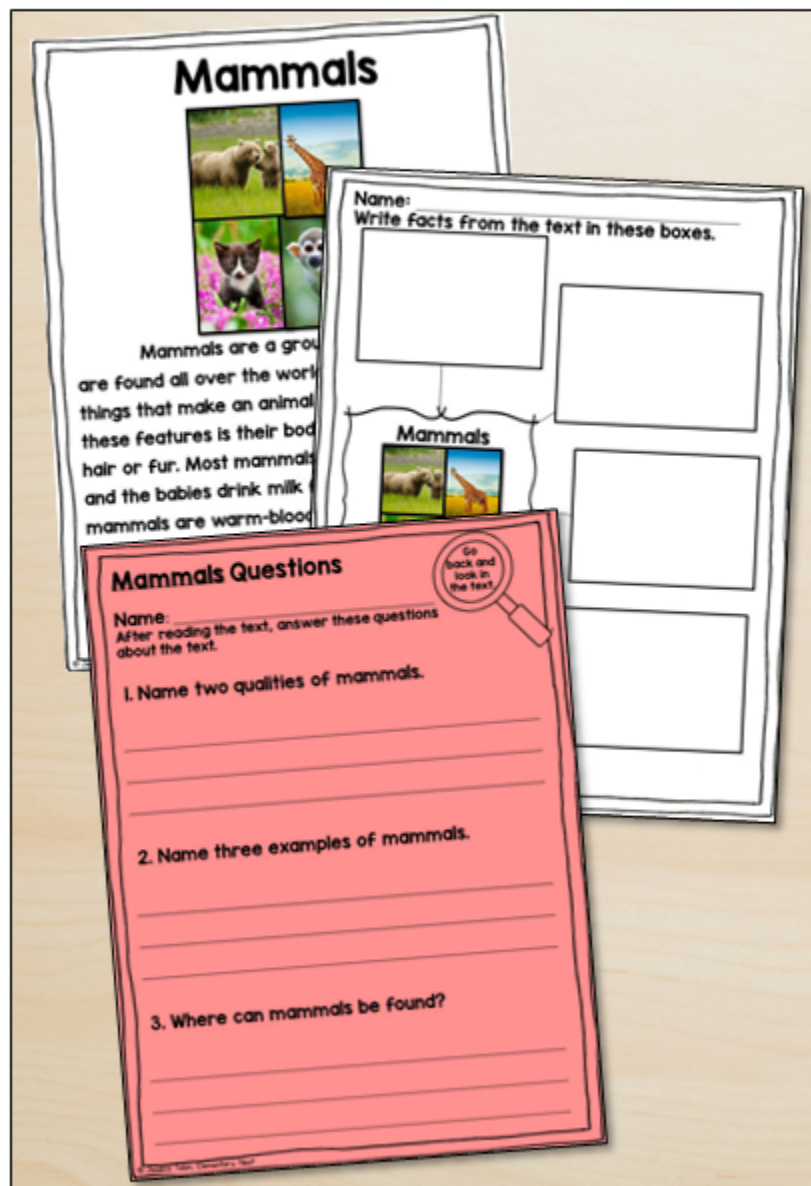

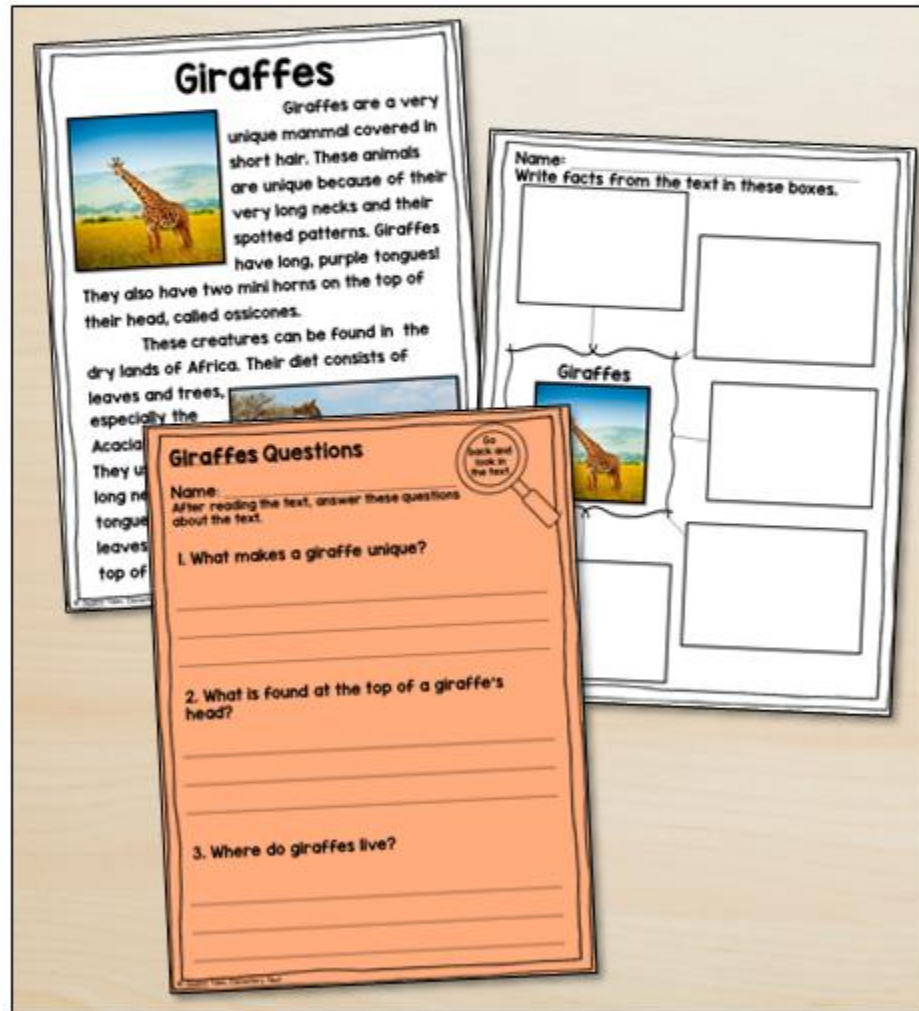

Giraffes

Kangaroos

Elephants



Elephants are one of our world's largest mammals. It is covered in a gray or brown leathery skin with short hair. One of the most interesting things on an elephant is its trunk. It uses its trunk to grab things. Their big ears help them stay cool.

Bears



Bears are a

thick body, with short and round ears and a pointed snout. They can weigh up to 700 pounds. They can stand on their back legs and sit up.

Bears eat plants and meat. There are different species of bears in the world. The brown bear is the largest.

Whales



Many people think that whales are fish, but they are actually mammals. They use their lungs to breathe.

They take in air, which is why they come to the surface so often. This is called breaching. Whales live their lives under water, usually in pods, or groups, of whales. They have long, thick bodies, two fins, and a big tail.

There are many types of whales, such as the humpback whale, and the blue whale. They are found in oceans.
