Early Life

Harriet Tubman was born into slavery in 1822 and suffered a serious head injury when her owner accidentally hit her with a metal weight when she was a child.

Fast Facts

- She was the first woman to lead an armed expedition in the Civil War
- In 2016, the U.S. Treasury announced she would be on the new \$20 bill
- She was nicknamed "Moses"

Her Big Achievement

Harriet Tubman is best known for her work freeing slaves during the 1850's. She would travel with them, often at night, to their final destination. They would use the Underground Railroad, which was a network of escape routes and safe houses set up for escaped slaves. Once Tubman got the newly freed people where they were going, she would then help them find jobs and set up their new lives. She was never caught freeing slaves.

Harriet Tubman

Harriet Tubman was born as a slave in 1822 and became known as America's most famous abolitionist, or someone who helps slaves escape. She escaped slavery by running away at 27 years old. She returned immediately to help her family escape and then to help friends escape slavery. After 1850, she helped the slaves get to Canada, where nobody would look for them anymore. She continued to do this and eventually freed more than 70 families who were enslaved. When the Civil War started in 1861, she joined the Union Army and eventually became a scout and spy. In her later years, she worked hard toward helping pass the law allowing women to vote.

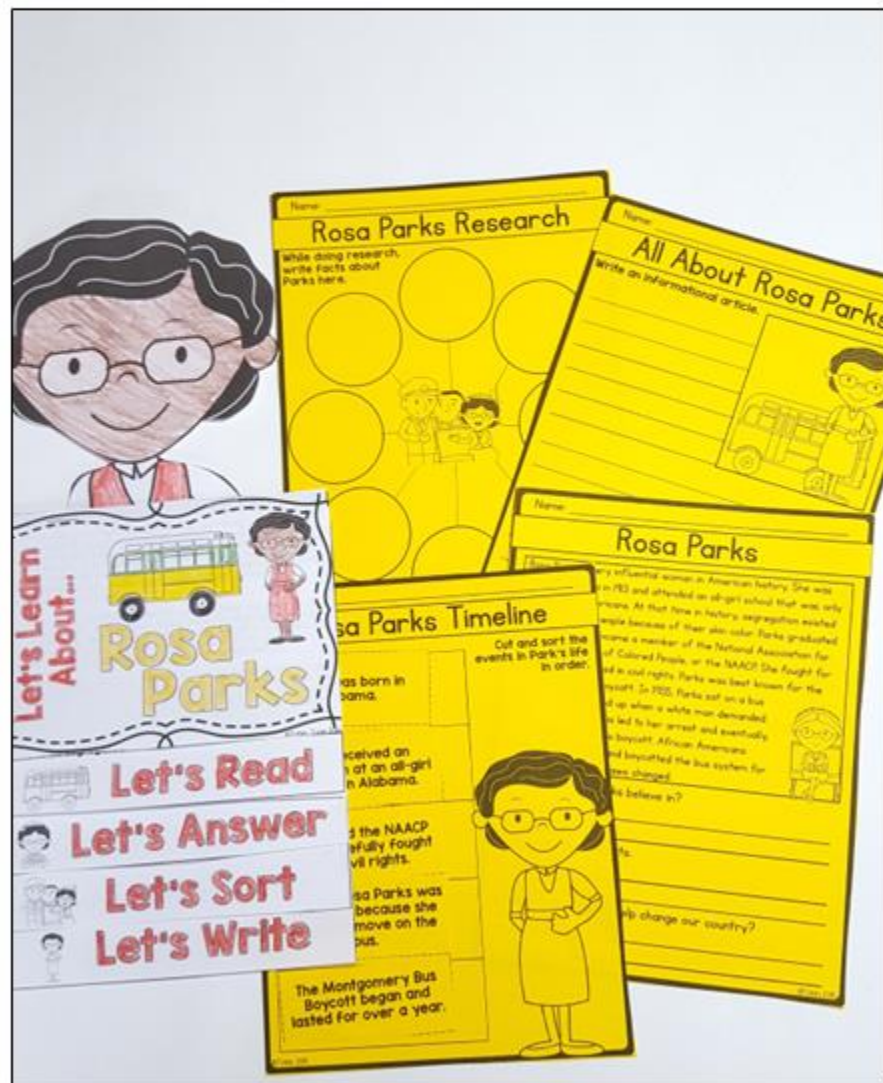

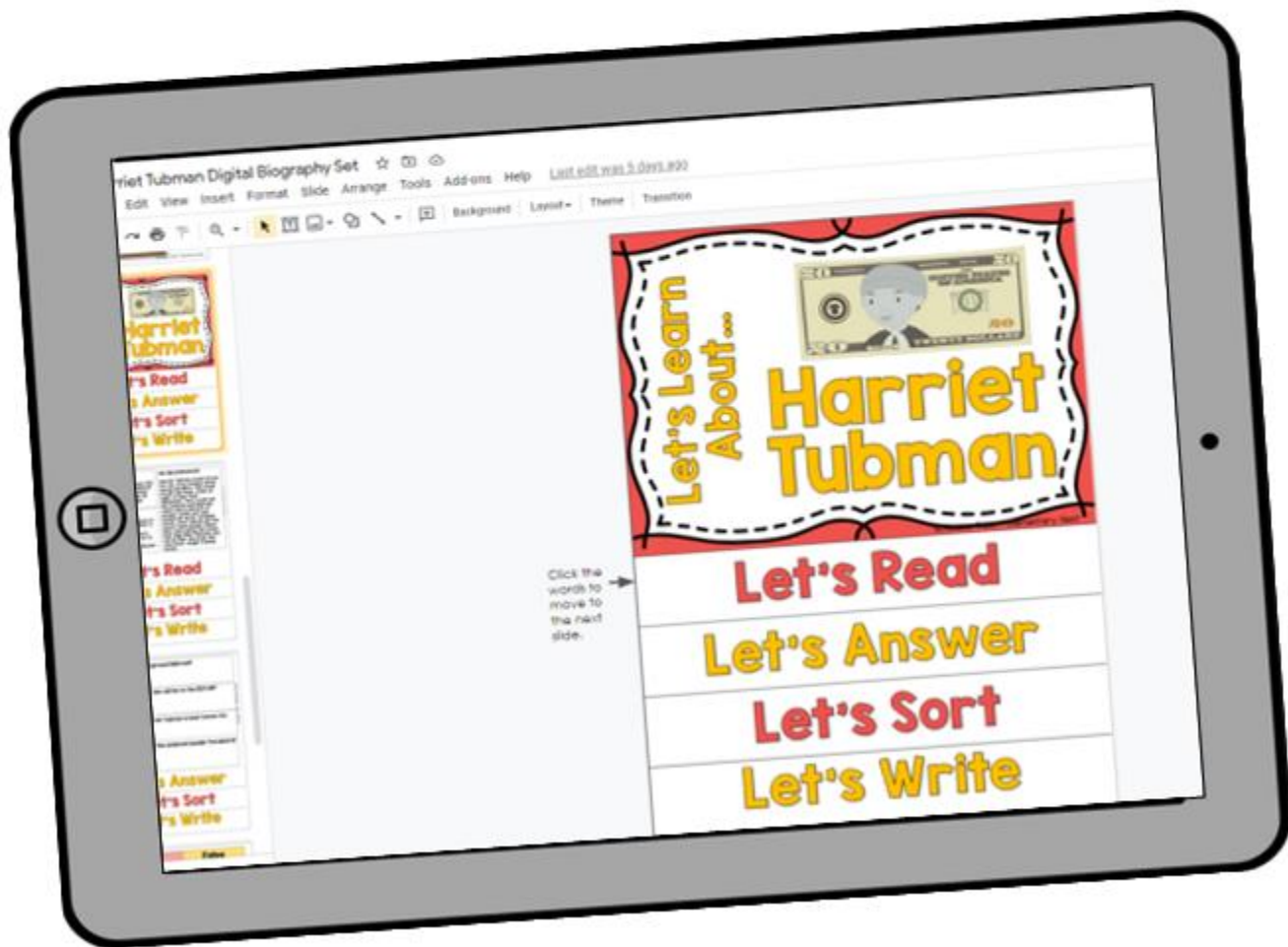
