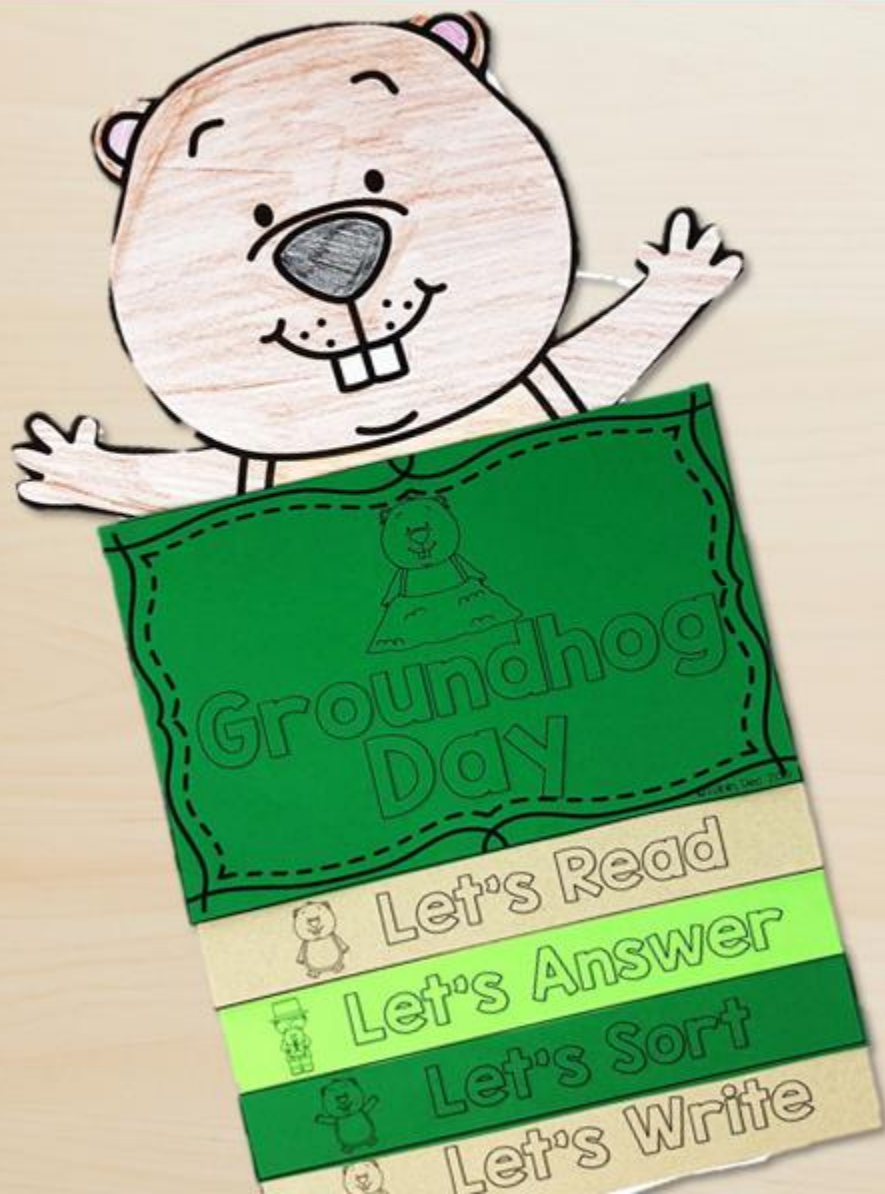

# LET'S READ PAGE

Groundhog Day is a holiday that happens in February. This holiday celebrates a groundhog who predicts the weather. It takes place on February 2<sup>nd</sup>. On this day, in Pennsylvania, a groundhog named Punxsutawney Phil comes out of its burrow, looks for its shadow, and predicts the upcoming weather.

The legend behind Phil's shadow is that it helps predict winter and spring weather. If Phil comes out of his burrow and sees his shadow, there will be six more weeks of winter. If Phil comes out of his burrow and does not see his shadow, then warmer spring weather will be coming soon. These legends are not proven to be true, but people love following this tradition.

Groundhog Day has changed a lot over time. It first started in only Punxsutawney, Pennsylvania. Then, it started spreading to the entire country. The holiday is even included in movies and has been on T.V. Punxsutawney Phil and his shadow are talked about on the news that morning. Text messages can even be sent to cell phones to alert people what Phil saw.

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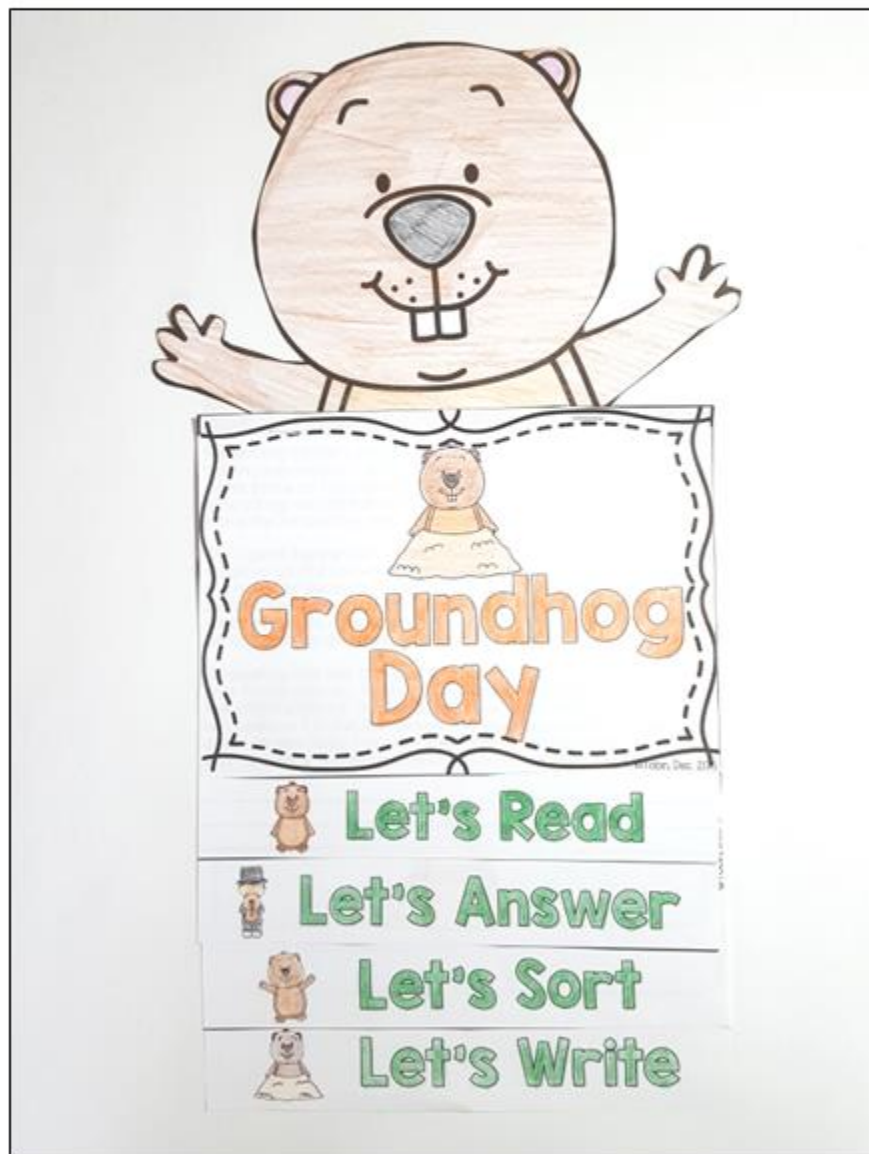
